**I. Recap of Annual Meeting, Nancy Keller**

**II. Nutrients**

After some discussion on the State's potential standards for nutrients and their potential impacts on small systems, Dennis suggested the Council send a letter of support for the state's revolving loan program. The letter will be posted on the Council's website.

### III. Open Discussion

- Dennis mentioned that there is legislation in Congress changing the definition of the waters of the United States from navigable waters to all waters. Dennis wants RMWEA to oppose the Bill - Clean Water Restoration act.

### Tour of the J. D. Philips Water Reclamation Facility, Colorado Springs

After the meeting, the group traveled to the Facility for a tour of the 20 mgd Reclamation Facility that was completed a few months ago at a cost of \$85 million, and serves the northern area of Colorado Springs. Presently, it is not discharging since it is going through a testing phase and the Las Vegas plant can treat the 8 mgd from the area. It cost less to build this plant than replace the interceptor line to the Las Vegas facility. The treated water will be used to water golf courses and parks in the northern area. The remainder of the treated water will be discharged to Monument Creek.

The tour concluded at 3:00 pm.
